1 / general anatomy, 2 / upper limb, 3 / lower limb, 4 / head and neck, 5 / thorax 6 / abdomen - digestive tract, abdominal wall, peritoneal cavity, 7 / abdomen, liver, bile ducts, pancreas, kidneys, spleen, 8 / pelvis, 9 / spine, spinal canal, peripheral nerves, 10 / brain, cranial nerves, 11 / sensory organs - smell, vision, hearing, neuropathways, 12/ transverse sections.

4 SCQ and 1 scheme randomly chosen from topics 2-11

5 SCQ randomly chosen from topic 1

5 schemes randomly chosen from topic 12

Evaluation according to the achieved points:

55-60 - excellent - the mark is final

50-54 - very good - the mark is final

45–49 – in case of the 1st attempt: the student passed the test, one more question (topic) needs to be answered within the subsequent oral examination; in case of passing, the final grade is C (good); in case of a failure, the grade is D, and the student needs to enroll for the 2nd attempt, the PC test.

45–49 – in case of the 2nd attempt: the student passed the test, one more question (topic) needs to be answered within the subsequent oral examination; in case of passing, the final grade is C (good); in case of failure, the grade is D, and the student needs to enroll for the 3rd attempt – the oral examination

0–44 – failed – the mark is final

The second re-exam (the third attempt): always exclusively oral examination – the students should answer 2 questions (topics) for the oral exam
